In addition to the above stated net oil sold in Ceyhan, 1,025,636 barrels were lifted in Ceyhan against money received at the end of June, and a further 1,920,042 barrels were refined locally at the Kalak and Bazian refineries. Therefore the net production, including the additional 632,815 barrels exported and added to the previously stored oil in Ceyhan was 17,755,254 barrels (572,750 barrels/day) during the month. There were no local sales or swaps in July.
